<p><b>Literacy:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The percentage of students in grades K-2 meeting the HCPSS Fountas and Pinnell benchmark end of year target will increase from 88.6% (187) to 90.6% with the gap between African American students and students overall decreasing.</li> </ul> <p><b>Mathematics:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Currently 62.1% of all students in grades 1-5 met the mathematics MAP target for the 2016 spring administration. We will increase to 67% by the 2017 spring administration.</li> <li>• Currently 36.7% of African American students in grades 1-5 met the mathematics MAP target for the 2016 spring administration. We will increase to 46.7% by the 2017 spring administration</li> </ul>
